VISAS-ON-ARRIVAL FOR TRAVELERS TO GHANA

Ghana Missions Abroad are encountering serious system challenges with the issuance of visas for potential travelers to Ghana. The situation has worsened over the past two weeks, creating mere chaotic scenes at some of the Ghana Missions.

In this connection, the Ghana Airports Company is being requested to urgently notify all Airlines operating in Ghana to allow passengers with <u>Special Authorization (Permit)</u> issued by a Ghana Mission Abroad to travel to Ghana on their Airlines (Only passengers with such authorization should be allowed to board as such authorization will be required for the processing of visas- on-arrival).
- 3. All such passengers will be issued <u>visas-on-arrival (at a fee)</u> at the Kotoka International Airport.
