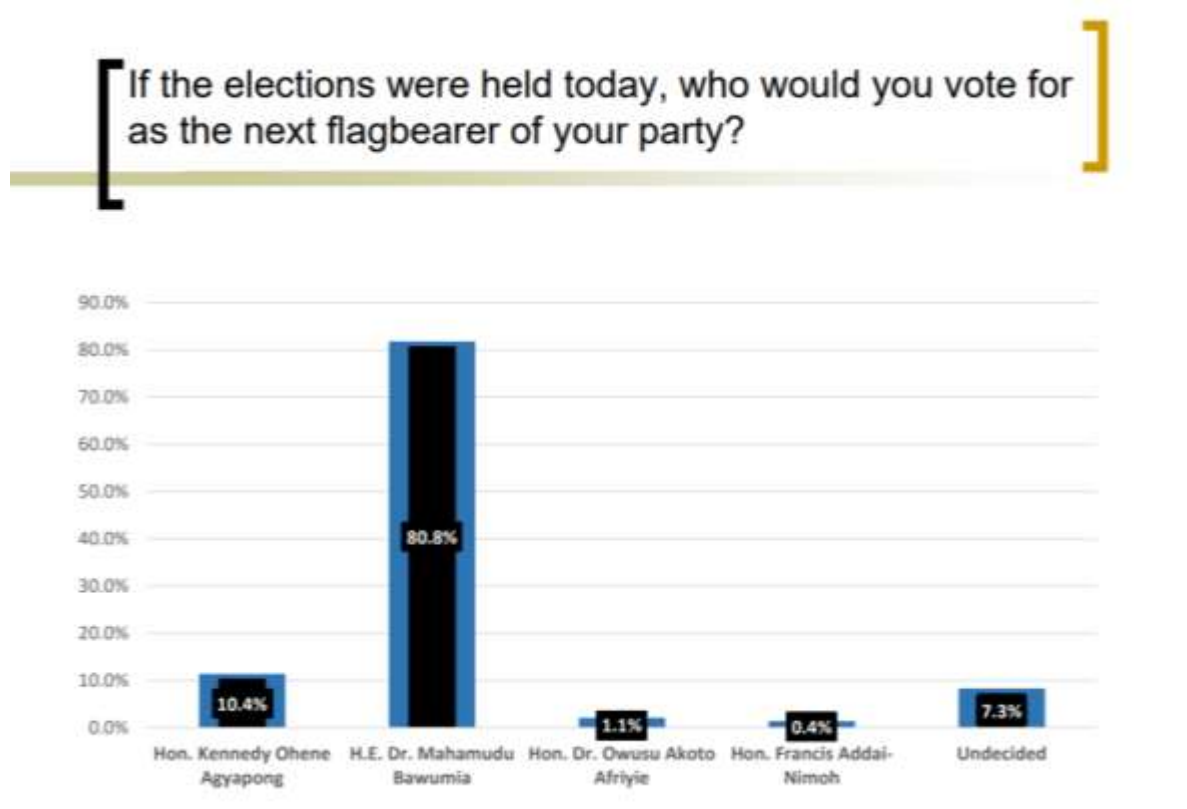


Dr. Bawumia Projected to lead the New Patriotic Party (NPP) by 80.8%: A Survey of NPP Polling Station Executives

In a recent poll conducted by Outcomes International, Ghana and Centre for Sustainable African Development Initiatives (C-SADI) UK, of Polling Station Executives across all 16 regions in Ghana, Dr. Mahamudu Bawumia is projected to secure a commanding 80.8% of the delegates' votes. Figure 1 below gives an indication of the standings for the various NPP flagbearer aspirants

According to the figure 1 above, H.E. Dr. Mahamudu Bawumia is projected to secure a staggering 80.8% of delegate support. Hon. Kennedy Agyapong follows with 10.4% of delegate support while Hon. Dr. Owusu Afriyie Akoto and Hon. Francis Addai-Nimoh are projected to secure 1.1% and 0.4% of delegate support, respectively. However, 7.3% of the delegates are yet to make a decision.

According to the survey, the question of whether or not delegates are likely to change their minds, as indicated in figure 2 below show that 86.4% of the delegates are not at all likely to change their minds while 9.6% of the delegates are slightly likely to change their minds. However, 3.9% are very likely to change their minds.
