RE: APPROVED FEES AND CHARGES FOR 2025/2026 ACADEMIC YEAR

I refer to your letter on the above, dated 12th January 2026.

Having noted the contents of your letter, I would like to draw your attention to a number of items that vary from the decisions reached at the consultative meeting held on Thursday January 8, 2026 at the Ministry of Education chaired by the Honourable Deputy Minister for Education, and including representatives of the Ghana Tertiary Education Commission, Chair of the University Council, management and student leaders of the University of Ghana.

1. The agreed rate for the UGSRC Development Levy was GH¢ 200.
2. The Telecel bundle was agreed at the originally stated price of GH¢ 312, with emphasis on the fact that this is an optional service, and the students needed to enhance communication to that effect, among their constituents. It was noted that this provides an enhanced data package, which was arrived at as a result of a survey conducted by the students.

Additionally, there was no discussion or decision during the meeting on the 75th anniversary levy, which is not a new line item. This contribution is towards the legacy project for the University's 75th anniversary: a Student Experience Centre for various student services. We are therefore not clear on the basis for the request to stop this levy after the current academic year.

We will continue to engage with GTEC and the Ministry towards implementation of the decisions taken during the meeting with the Honourable Deputy Minister.
