**NOTICE TO JEWELLERY MANUFACTURERS, FABRICATORS AND GOLD
REFINERIES**

COMPLIANCE NOTICE NO. GOLDBOD/2026/01

It has come to the attention of the Ghana Gold Board ("GoldBod") that some jewellery manufacturers, fabricators and gold refineries are operating without a valid licence from the GoldBod.

The GoldBod reminds the general public that only duly licensed persons are authorised to engage in gold trading, jewellery manufacturing, gold fabrication and gold refining businesses in Ghana.

Engaging in these activities without a valid GoldBod licence constitutes an offence and punishable under Act 1140.

On October 22, 2025, the GoldBod issued a press statement which indicated that all existing jewellery manufacturers, fabricators and gold refineries were required to regularize their operations latest by 31st December 2025.

In the light of the above, a team of GoldBod Inspectors would be deployed from Monday, February 2, 2026 to ensure that only duly licensed persons engage in jewellery manufacturing, gold fabrication and gold refining businesses in Ghana.

The GoldBod also wishes to congratulate the following jewellery manufacturing entities that have successfully been issued with a GoldBod jewellery & fabrication licence;
