### FAULT ON A FEEDER AT SMELTER-2 SUBSTATION, TEMA

**Tema, Tuesday, 24<sup>th</sup> February 2026** --- The Ghana Grid Company LTD. (GRIDCo) wishes to inform the public that at **22:58 hrs. on Monday, 23<sup>rd</sup> February 2026**, an electrical fault occurred at the Smelter II substation in Tema, resulting in a power outage affecting some customers in Tema.

Our engineers are currently diagnosing the cause of the disturbance and working diligently to restore power supply to the affected areas as quickly as possible.

GRIDCo sincerely apologises for the inconvenience caused and assures all affected customers that every effort is being made to resolve the challenge promptly and restore stable power supply.

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#### **Note to Editors:**

Ghana Grid Company Limited (GRIDCo) was incorporated in December 2006 to carry out the economic dispatching and transmission of electricity from facilities of wholesale suppliers (Independent Power Producers [IPPs]) to bulk customers and distribution utilities in Ghana and West Africa. The Company became operational on August 1, 2008, following the transfer of the Transmission System Department and its core staff from VRA to GRIDCo. It operates the National Interconnected Transmission System (NITS). GRIDCo currently transmits electricity to thirty-one (31) Bulk Customers and Distribution Utilities from eleven (11) Wholesale Suppliers, including the Volta River Authority (VRA).
