POLICE INVESTIGATE ALLEGED ARSON ATTACK AT CHURCH PREMISES IN ACCRA

1. The Accra Regional Police Command has arrested a suspect in connection with an alleged arson attack at the premises of Grace Town Power Ministry Headquarters (Alpha Hour), located within the Mile 7 District of the Tesano Division.
2. On Monday, 9th February 2026, police gathered information to the effect that a suspect, identified as Kesse Okyerewaa Koranteng, unlawfully entered the church premises, sprinkled petrol in the auditorium, and set the place on fire.
3. Preliminary investigations revealed that the suspect entered the church auditorium with a liquid substance contained in rubber containers, sprinkled the substance within the auditorium, and ignited it using matches, resulting in the outbreak of fire.
4. Items destroyed in the fire included air conditioners, chairs, windows, ten (10) offering boxes, ceiling materials, electrical cables, and the lighting system.
5. The Police visited the scene and retrieved four (4) rubber containers suspected to have been used in committing the offence.
6. The suspect has been cautioned and is currently in Police custody, assisting with ongoing investigations.
7. The Accra Regional Police Command assures the public of its commitment to ensuring safety and security and urges members of the public to promptly report any suspicious activities to the Police
