CESSATION OF ENGAGEMENT WITH PROF. EMMANUEL OHENE AFOAKWA AS VICE-CHANCELLOR

Reference is made to the letter dated 3rd February 2026 (Ref: GCTU/GC/OVC/01/26), titled "Notification of End of Secondment Tenure," which formally notified Prof. Emmanuel Ohene Afoakwa that his secondment as Vice-Chancellor would end on 28th February 2026.

The secondment will accordingly expire effective 28th February 2026, and his voluntary retirement will also effect from the same date.

In view of the foregoing, you are hereby notified that with effect from 28th February 2026; Prof. Emmanuel Ohene Afoakwa is no longer authorized to act in the capacity of Vice-Chancellor. He shall not issue directives, sign documents, make representations, approve transactions, or undertake any official act on behalf of the University in that capacity. Any such action taken after this effective date shall be deemed unauthorized and of no legal effect.

You are therefore directed to ensure the immediate cessation of any formal engagement with Prof. Emmanuel Ohene Afoakwa as Vice-Chancellor.

Furthermore, all institutional records, communication platforms, official representations, signatories, and external notifications must be updated accordingly without delay to reflect this change.

You are also required to circulate this directive to all officers, staff, management, committees, and relevant stakeholders of the University for strict compliance.
