**SUBJECT: INQUIRY REGARDING NON-CONSTRUCTION OF DAMANG  
INNER ROADS UNDER CORPORATE SOCIAL COMMITMENTS LINKED  
TO THE STABILITY AGREEMENT**

We write with reference to the Stability Agreement between the Government of Ghana and Damang Goldfields Limited, under which the company has enjoyed defined fiscal and operational terms for its mining activities in the Damang area. It is public record that, as part of broader engagements accompanying the Stability Agreement and subsequent corporate social responsibility commitments to host communities, Damang Goldfields undertook to support key infrastructure development, including the construction and rehabilitation of inner roads within the Damang Township. This commitment was reiterated during stakeholder engagements with the Prestea Huni-Valley Municipal Assembly and traditional authorities. As of today, our checks indicate the Damang inner roads remain unconstructed and continue to deteriorate. Residents report significant hardship, increased transportation costs, and restricted access to markets, schools, and health facilities. These conditions

are inconsistent with the principles of sustainable mining and community development envisaged under the Stability Agreement framework.

**In the public interest, we respectfully request:**

- Clarification on the current status of the commitment to construct the Damang inner roads;
- An explanation for the delay in executing this project despite continued operations and the fiscal stability afforded the company under the Agreement;
- A definitive timeline for the commencement and completion of the road works.

Given the urgency and public concern surrounding this matter, we request a formal written response within three (3) working days of receipt of this letter. We are available for a stakeholder meeting to discuss an actionable plan and will reflect your response, or lack thereof, in our subsequent reporting.
