## **PRESS STATEMENT COMMENDING GES AND WAEC ON ACTION AGAINST EXAMINATION MALPRACTICE AND UPDATES ON NATIONAL EXAMINATIONS**

The Ghana National Education Campaign Coalition (GNECC) commends the Ghana Education Service (GES) and the West African Examinations Council (WAEC) for their recent announcement on sanctions and reported convictions of individuals involved in examination malpractice. This decisive action is in the right direction and reinforces efforts to uphold the integrity of Ghana's examination system.

We also acknowledge the recent updates provided on the Basic Education Certificate Examination (BECE), as well as the ongoing West African Senior School Certificate Examination (WASSCE). The shift in the examination calendar, with WASSCE preceding BECE and both overlapping, requires heightened coordination and vigilance.

GNECC believes the enforcement of sanctions will serve as a strong deterrent to candidates, invigilators, and other actors who may seek to undermine the credibility of national examinations. We therefore encourage all candidates to conduct themselves with honesty and integrity.

We further urge authorities to sustain these efforts through strengthened supervision, secure handling of examination materials, and adequate resourcing of centers to ensure a smooth and credible process.

We wish all candidates success in their examinations.
