

**PETITION BY A COALITION OF ELECTORAL AREA COORDINATORS IN
THE GREATER ACCRA REGION REGARDING THE CONDUCT OF HON.
KENNEDY OHENE AGYAPONG**

Dear Sir,

We, the undersigned Electoral Area Coordinators from the eight operational zones of the Greater Accra Region of the New Patriotic Party, respectfully submit this petition to the National Party leadership regarding the conduct and public utterances of Hon. Kennedy Ohene Agyapong, which we believe are having an adverse effect on Party unity, grassroots morale and preparations towards the 2028 general elections.

As Electoral Area Coordinators, we constitute the frontline of the Party's grassroots machinery. We are in constant engagement with polling station executives, Party activists, identifiable groups, floating voters and ordinary members. Consequently, we are among the first to experience the practical effects of statements and actions that create uncertainty, confusion or divisions within the Party.

Over the past several months, we have observed with increasing concern a pattern of public commentary by Hon. Kennedy Ohene Agyapong directed at Party leaders, Party institutions

and official Party positions. While every member of the Party is entitled to his or her views, repeated public attacks on constituted Party organs create the impression of a Party at war with itself and weaken confidence among our members and supporters.

At a time when the Party is expected to be rebuilding, reorganising, and preparing for victory in the 2028 elections, such public disputes have become a recurring subject of discussion among our grassroots members. In many instances, Electoral Area Coordinators and constituency executives are required to spend valuable time responding to concerns from members who are confused by conflicting public messages coming from senior members of the Party.

We are particularly concerned by reports of a recent media interview in which Hon. Kennedy Agyapong allegedly threatened to disclose confidential information and documents relating to the affairs of the Party. We attach copies of relevant reports and recordings available to us in support of this petition.

If any member of the Party is in possession of credible evidence of wrongdoing, misconduct, corruption, abuse of office or breaches of Party rules, such information should be submitted to the appropriate Party organs and lawful authorities for investigation and action. We do not believe that allegations of wrongdoing should remain the subject of recurring public threats or suggestions, as this creates suspicion around the entire Party and unfairly damages the reputation of many innocent members.

We therefore respectfully call upon the National Executive Committee to encourage Hon. Kennedy Oshene Agyapong to submit any evidence or information in his possession to the appropriate authorities and Party organs so that any alleged wrongdoing may be properly investigated and addressed. Such a process would strengthen public confidence in the Party's

commitment to accountability and transparency.

As Electoral Area Coordinators, we are already engaged in the difficult task of rebuilding confidence among Party members following the 2024 electoral defeat. We believe that the success of the Party in 2028 will depend significantly on discipline, unity of purpose, message consistency and respect for constituted authority.

Accordingly, we respectfully request that the National Executive Committee:

1. Review the recent public conduct and statements of Hon. Kennedy Ohene Agyapong.
2. Determine whether such conduct is consistent with the principles, traditions and constitutional provisions of the Party.
3. Invite him to submit any documentary evidence or information in his possession regarding alleged wrongdoing by any Party member to the appropriate authorities and Party organs.
4. Take appropriate measures to preserve Party unity, discipline and cohesion.
5. Strengthen guidance on public communications by senior Party members on matters involving official Party positions.
6. Reassure Party members across the country that the Party remains united and focused on the objective of returning to government in 2028.

We submit this petition not out of hostility towards any individual but out of concern for the unity, stability and future success of the New Patriotic Party.

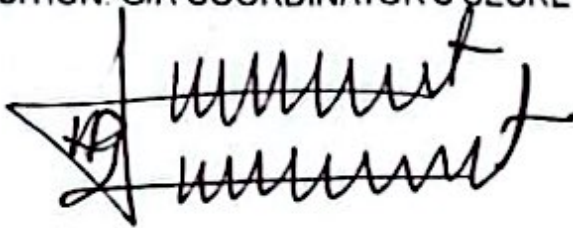

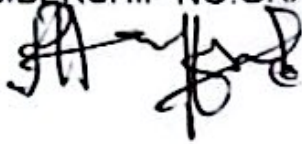
