

STATEMENT BY OBAATANPA RADIO FOLLOWING AN ATTACK ON THE STATION EARLIER TODAY

Obaatanpa Radio wishes to inform its listeners, stakeholders, and the general public of an unfortunate incident that occurred at the station this morning.

The Municipal Chief Executive for Awutu Senya East, Hon. Seth Serwono Banini, the Central Regional Chairman of the NDC, Dr. Richard Kofi Asiedu, and some individuals stormed the premises of Obaatanpa Radio following discussions on the station's morning show concerning internal matters of the party.

During the incident, the Morning Show Host and Producer were verbally and physically attacked. The group entered the studios, switched off the station during live transmission, ordered workers out of the building, and locked up the premises.

Management strongly condemns this attack on our staff and the disruption of our operations. Such actions threaten press freedom and the safety of media practitioners.

A formal complaint has been lodged with the Central East Regional Police Command for investigation. We commend the Police for their swift intervention and professionalism.

We call on the relevant authorities to ensure that all persons involved are brought to book. In due course, the station will release CCTV footage of the incident to support ongoing investigations.

Obaatanpa Radio remains committed to professional, fair, and responsible broadcasting.
