**PETITION ON BEHALF OF AGGRIEVED MEMBERS OF THE ABLEKUMA WEST
CONSTITUENCY REGARDING UNLAWFUL REMOVAL FROM THE ELECTORAL REGISTER
AND DISPLACEMENT FROM ELECTED OFFICE**

1. I act as Solicitor for and on behalf of the aggrieved members of the New Patriotic Party in Ablekuma West, whose names, polling stations and membership identification numbers are set out in the **Schedule** to this Petition ("our Clients"), all being registered members of the New Patriotic Party in good standing within the **Ablekuma West Constituency** in the Greater Accra Region, on whose express instructions we submit this Petition to the National Executive Committee ("NEC") of the Party.
2. At the Polling Station Executive elections held at the Ave Maria "B" Polling Station, my Clients duly submitted their Nomination Forms, satisfied all the qualification and eligibility requirements, were vetted, and were acclaimed unopposed as Polling Station Officers. Having been so acclaimed, my Clients were accordingly sworn into their respective offices.
3. It was therefore to my Clients' utter dismay that, upon the release of the electoral register for the Constituency, they discovered that their names had been removed from the register and replaced with the names of two persons who are unknown to the members of their respective polling stations, who did not submit any Nomination Forms, who did not contest any election, and who do not attend meetings at the respective polling stations.
4. My Clients were neither notified of, nor did they consent to, the removal of their names. No lawful basis whatsoever has been given for their removal. The persons purportedly substituted in their stead did not go through any of the processes prescribed by the Party's *Rules and Regulations for the Conduct of the Internal Elections*, under which only members duly nominated, vetted, and elected or acclaimed may hold office.

5. The removal of my Clients' names and their replacement by persons who never stood for election is unlawful, void, and of no effect. It disregards the express outcome of the elections at the respective polling stations, nullifies the acclamation and swearing-in of my Clients, and denies them the offices to which they were duly elected.
6. The wrong done to my Clients is not an isolated one. I am further instructed by the additional aggrieved members of the Party, drawn from a number of polling stations across the Ablekuma West Constituency, each of whom has suffered like injury at the hands of those responsible for the compilation of the register. Each of them is a registered member of the Party in good standing whose entitlement to participate in the Party's internal elections has been defeated by the same fraudulent manipulation of the electoral register. My Clients share a common grievance arising from the same corrupted register and the same conduct of the Regional Executive Committee, and they join in this Petition seeking redress. This Petition is accordingly brought on behalf of all the aggrieved members named herein and in the Schedule
7. After the Polling Station Executives had been duly elected, acclaimed, and sworn into office, the electoral register of the Constituency was clandestinely altered and manipulated. The particulars of the irregularities and fraud complained of, which affected our Clients and the members named in the Schedule across the polling stations of the Constituency, are as follows:
- (i) Persons who had been duly elected, acclaimed, and sworn in as Polling Station Executives were clandestinely and unlawfully removed from the electoral register without their knowledge, notice, or consent.
 - (ii) New names and persons who had not been elected to any office were surreptitiously inserted into the electoral register as Polling Station Officers.
 - (iii) Persons who did not vote at a particular Polling Station were entered into the electoral register as officers of that very Polling Station.
 - (iv) Persons who do not attend Polling Station meetings were made officers of a Polling Station without going through any of the processes prescribed by the Rules and Regulations.
 - (v) Persons who have not attended Polling Station meetings for over four (4) years were clandestinely inserted into the electoral register as officers.
 - (vi) Persons who did not submit any Nomination Forms, and who therefore never stood as candidates, were inserted into the electoral register as elected officers.
 - (vii) Persons who actually contested and lost the Polling Station elections nonetheless ended up in the electoral register as officers.
8. These acts were not innocent clerical errors. They were deliberate, systematic, and concealed manipulations of the register, carried out under the supervision of, and/or with the connivance of, the Regional Representatives deployed to the Constituency, and designed to replace duly elected officers with persons who had no lawful entitlement to be on the register. They constitute a fraud perpetrated upon the membership of the Party in the Ablekuma West Constituency, of which the cases of our Clients are specific instances.



9. Upon discovering that they had been removed from the register, my Clients duly complained to the Regional Executive Committee of the Greater Accra Region. Nothing was done about their complaint. Instead, in a rather undemocratic manner, the Regional Executive Committee went ahead and conducted the elections for the Electoral Area Officers using the fraudulently compiled electoral register. The integrity of those elections is therefore called into question, tainted as they are by a register that unlawfully excluded duly elected officers such as our Clients and included persons who were never elected at all.
10. The Regional Executive Committee having done nothing about my Clients' complaints, and having instead proceeded with the elections on the strength of the very register complained of, my Clients have been left without redress at the Regional level. It has therefore become necessary to petition the National Executive Committee, as the body vested with the authority to remedy this injustice and to secure the restoration of my Clients to the offices to which they were duly elected.
11. My Clients are aware that the manipulation of the Constituency's electoral register is the subject of separate and wider complaints. This Petition, however, is confined to the specific and personal injustice done to my Clients, and seeks their individual redress. It is not intended to duplicate any other petition, but to place squarely before the NEC the distinct grievance of my Clients and to obtain the restoration of their elected positions.


RELIEFS SOUGHT

WHEREFORE, on behalf of my Clients, I respectfully pray the National Executive Committee to:

- (a) **Investigate** the circumstances surrounding the removal of the names of my Clients named in the Schedule hereto, from the electoral register of their respective Polling Stations, and the insertion in their stead of persons who did not contest the election, with a view to identifying those responsible;
- (b) **Reinstate** my Clients to their rightful places on the electoral register and to any offices to which they were duly elected or acclaimed, upon the investigation confirming their entitlement;
- (c) **Correct** the electoral register accordingly, by reinstating the names of my Clients and expunging the names of the persons unlawfully substituted for them; and
- (d) **Grant** such further or other relief as the National Executive Committee shall consider just in the circumstances.

I trust that this Petition will receive the urgent and favourable consideration of the National Executive Committee.


