The views, allegations, assertions and conclusions contained in that publication are entirely those of the publisher and should not, under any circumstances, be construed as representing the position of RMG Company Ltd.

The Company further wishes to strongly dissociate itself from the litany of complaints, allegations and political assertions contained in the publication, including any suggestion that the Government of Ghana or its officials supported or facilitated the takeover of RMG's mining operations. RMG Company Ltd is not associated with such claims and does not wish to be drawn into political discourse or partisan controversy.

RMG Company Ltd has consistently maintained a professional, cordial and constructive working relationship with the Government of Ghana and its institutions. The Company believes that the mining industry can only thrive through collaboration, mutual respect and adherence to the laws and regulatory framework governing the sector.

The Management wishes to express its profound appreciation to the Hon. Minister for Lands and Natural Resources and the leadership and technical staff of the Minerals Commission for their sound leadership, guidance and continuous engagement with the Company. Their support has been instrumental in assisting RMG Company Ltd in restructuring its operations and laying a solid foundation for the restoration of its mining activities.

RMG remains committed to its investment in Ghana and is actively working towards the full restoration of its operations with the objective of creating sustainable employment opportunities for over 5,000 young Ghanaians, while operating in strict compliance with all applicable laws, environmental standards and regulatory requirements.
