**PETITION AGAINST THE COMPILATION OF THE ELECTORAL REGISTER FOR
THE ABLEKUMA WEST CONSTITUENCY AND THE CONDUCT OF THE
ELECTORAL AREA EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE ELECTIONS HELD THEREON**

A. INTRODUCTION

1. We, the undersigned, being registered members and Polling Station Executives of the New Patriotic Party ("the Party") in good standing within the Ablekuma West Constituency in the Greater Accra Region, respectfully submit this Petition to the National Executive Committee ("NEC") of the Party, for the urgent attention of the General Secretary, pursuant to the appeal and dispute-resolution provisions of

the *Rules and Regulations for the Conduct of the Internal Elections of the Party (2026)* and other relevant provisions of the Constitution of the New Patriotic Party (as amended).

2. This Petition concerns grave irregularities and acts of fraud perpetrated in the compilation of the electoral register for the Ablekuma West Constituency, and the consequent conduct of the Electoral Area Executive Committee elections on the basis of that compromised register. The matters complained of strike at the very heart of the credibility, transparency, and fairness that the Party has solemnly committed itself to in its 2026 internal electoral reforms, and which the Oquaye Election Review Committee identified as essential to the Party's rebuilding agenda ahead of the 2028 General Elections.
3. We bring this Petition in good faith, in defence of the democratic rights of the membership of the Party in Ablekuma West, and with the singular objective of ensuring that the executives who manage the affairs of the Party at every level in the Constituency are persons duly and properly elected in accordance with the Party's Rules and Regulations.

B. BACKGROUND

4. By the Party's *Guidelines and Timelines for the 2026 Membership Registration and Internal Party Elections*, the Party undertook a comprehensive registration of members between 1st and 31st March 2026, followed by data entry, verification, and a sequenced programme of internal elections from the Polling Station level upwards.
5. Under the said Rules and Regulations, only members whose names are duly captured in the official membership register at the Polling Station are eligible to vote or contest, and the electoral register and the album of elected executives are required to be compiled, verified by the Constituency Executive Committee, and validated by the Regional Steering Committee.
6. In accordance with the timelines, the Polling Station Executive elections in the Ablekuma West Constituency were duly held. Members attended Polling Station meetings, candidates were nominated and vetted, and Polling Station Executives were elected, whether by ballot or by acclamation where there was a single aspirant, and were thereafter sworn in. The Electoral Area Executive Committee members are, by the Rules and Regulations, to be elected by all the Polling Station Executives within the relevant Electoral Area.
7. The conduct of the elections in the Constituency was supervised by Regional Representatives deployed by the National Secretariat, acting on behalf of the Regional Steering Committee, pursuant to the letter of the General Secretary referenced **NPP/HQ/2026/03/27/GS** dated 27th March 2026.

8. Pursuant to the approved timelines, the elections for the Electoral Area Officers in the Constituency were originally scheduled to be held from 10th June to 16th June 2026. However, on account of the very issues regarding the compilation of the electoral register that are the subject of this Petition, those elections could not be held on the scheduled dates. The elections were consequently postponed and re-scheduled to be held on 26th June 2026. The postponement is itself a clear acknowledgement that the electoral register was known to be defective and in need of correction before any election could properly be held upon it.
9. It is in respect of the compilation of the electoral register following these Polling Station elections, and the conduct of the Electoral Area elections thereon, that this Petition is brought.

C. THE IRREGULARITIES AND PARTICULARS OF FRAUD

10. After the Polling Station Executives had been duly elected, acclaimed, and sworn into office, the electoral register of the Constituency was clandestinely altered and manipulated. The particulars of the irregularities and fraud complained of are as follows:
 - (i) Persons who had been duly elected, acclaimed, and sworn in as Polling Station Executives were clandestinely and unlawfully removed from the electoral register without their knowledge, notice, or consent.
 - (ii) New names and persons who had not been elected to any office were surreptitiously inserted into the electoral register as Polling Station Officers.
 - (iii) Persons who did not vote at a particular Polling Station were entered into the electoral register as officers of that very Polling Station.
 - (iv) Persons who do not attend Polling Station meetings were made officers of a Polling Station without going through any of the processes prescribed by the Rules and Regulations.
 - (v) Persons who have not attended Polling Station meetings for over four (4) years were clandestinely inserted into the electoral register as officers.
 - (vi) Persons who did not submit any Nomination Forms, and who therefore never stood as candidates, were inserted into the electoral register as elected officers.
 - (vii) Persons who actually contested and lost the Polling Station elections nonetheless ended up in the electoral register as officers.
11. These acts were carried out under the supervision of, and/or with the connivance of, the Regional Representatives deployed to the Constituency. The cumulative effect of these acts is that the electoral register for the Ablekuma West

Constituency does not reflect the true and lawful outcome of the Polling Station elections, and is fundamentally compromised, corrupted, and unreliable.

12. We respectfully submit that the alterations described above were not innocent clerical errors. They were deliberate, systematic, and concealed manipulations of the register designed to replace duly elected officers with persons who had no lawful entitlement to be on the register. They constitute, in our respectful view, a fraud perpetrated upon the membership of the Party in Ablekuma West.

D. COMPLAINTS TO THE REGIONAL EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE AND THE CONDUCT OF THE ELECTORAL AREA ELECTIONS

13. Upon discovery of these irregularities, several complaints were made to the Regional Executive Committee of the Greater Accra Region, drawing attention to the manipulation of the electoral register and demanding its correction. Despite these repeated complaints, nothing was done to remedy the situation.
14. On the eve of the Electoral Area Officers' elections, the Chairman of the Constituency Executive Committee, who also serves as the Constituency Chairman of the Party, recognising the gravity of the situation, issued a notice calling for the suspension of the elections so that the electoral register might first be corrected.
15. Notwithstanding that notice from the Chairman of the Constituency Executive Committee, and notwithstanding the unresolved complaints and the earlier postponement of the elections on account of those very register issues, the Regional Executive Committee proceeded to conduct the Electoral Area Executive Committee elections on 26th June 2026 on the basis of the very register that was the subject of the complaints. The elections were therefore conducted upon a register that was widely known to be compromised.
16. In the premises, the Regional Executive Committee, acting in connivance with certain persons, have perpetrated fraud on the members of the New Patriotic Party in the Ablekuma West Constituency in the compilation of the electoral register and in the conduct of the elections held thereon.

E. THE HISTORY OF PROBLEMS WITH THE ABLEKUMA WEST REGISTER

17. This is not the first occasion on which the integrity of the electoral register in the Ablekuma West Constituency has been called into question. There has been a recurring history of problems with the electoral register in Ablekuma West since the very inception of the Constituency. Some of these issues have been the subject of extensive litigation before the courts. The matters now complained of are therefore a continuation and aggravation of a long-standing and unresolved problem that demands a decisive and lasting intervention from the national leadership of the Party.

F. THE FRAUD UNDERMINES THE CONSTITUTIONAL AND POLITICAL RIGHTS OF NPP MEMBERS IN THE CONSTITUENCY

18. Beyond the breach of the Party's own Rules and Regulations, the irregularities and fraud complained of strike at a deeper and more fundamental concern. A fraudulent electoral register and the corrupted electoral process built upon it undermine the political rights of the members of the New Patriotic Party in the Ablekuma West Constituency and deny them their constitutional right to participate freely and meaningfully in the affairs of a political party in a democratic society.
19. The right to form and to participate in political parties, and the requirement that the internal organisation of a political party conform to democratic principles, are guaranteed under Article 55 of the 1992 Constitution of the Republic of Ghana. When members are made to attend Polling Station meetings, to register, to contest and to vote, only for the outcome of those processes to be secretly reversed by the clandestine manipulation of the register, the participation of those members is rendered hollow and illusory. Their votes are nullified, their elected representatives are displaced by impostors, and their voice in the affairs of the Party is silenced. This is the very antithesis of democratic participation.
20. The Party cannot, and should not, countenance such acts. This is especially so at the present moment, when the delegates system of the Party is itself under direct constitutional challenge before the Supreme Court of Ghana. In the case brought by Professor Kwabena Frimpong-Boateng, Dr. Nyaho Nyaho-Tamakloe and Dr. Christine Amoako-Nuamah, in which the New Patriotic Party is a defendant, and which is supported by the Attorney-General, the plaintiffs seek a declaration that the delegate-based electoral systems of the Party and other parties are unconstitutional, contending that they exclude the ordinary membership and offend the democratic principles of equality and participation guaranteed by the Constitution. Judgment in that suit is awaited.
21. It would be gravely damaging to the Party's cause, both in the courtroom and in the court of public opinion, for the Party to tolerate the very evils of exclusion, manipulation, and disenfranchisement of which the delegates system is accused, at the precise moment when it is called upon to defend that system as consistent with democratic principles. To allow a fraudulent register to stand in Ablekuma West would lend credence to the case against the delegates system and expose the Party to the charge that its internal democracy is a mere façade.
22. The Party should instead seize this matter as an opportunity. By acting decisively to annul the fraudulent register and to vindicate the genuine choices of its members in Ablekuma West, the Party can demonstrate, to Ghanaians generally and to the members of the New Patriotic Party in Ablekuma West in particular, that its delegates system, properly and honestly administered, faithfully reflects

the constitutional principles of political participation in a democracy such as Ghana. The integrity of the system depends on the integrity of the register from which the delegates are drawn; defending the one requires protecting the other.

G. THE NEED FOR THE INTERVENTION OF THE NATIONAL EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE

23. Having exhausted the avenues available at the Constituency and Regional levels without redress, and the Regional Executive Committee being itself implicated in the irregularities complained of, it has become both necessary and proper to bring these matters before the National Executive Committee, which is vested with the authority and responsibility to ensure the integrity of the Party's internal electoral processes nationwide and to resolve these irregularities.
24. Unless the National Executive Committee intervenes, persons who were never elected by the membership will sit as executives of the Party in Ablekuma West, the rights of the duly elected officers and the membership will be defeated, and the credibility of the Party's internal elections in the Constituency will be irreparably damaged.

H. RELIEFS SOUGHT

WHEREFORE, your Petitioners humbly and respectfully pray the National Executive Committee for the following reliefs:

- (a) **AN ANNULMENT** of the electoral register compiled for the Ablekuma West Constituency on the ground that it was fraudulently and irregularly compiled and does not reflect the true and lawful outcome of the Polling Station elections.
- (b) **A DIRECTIVE** that a full, independent, and impartial investigation be conducted into the allegations of irregularity and fraud set out in this Petition, and into the compilation of the electoral register for the Ablekuma West Constituency, with a view to identifying and sanctioning all persons responsible.
- (c) **A DECISION** declaring null and void, and of no effect, the Electoral Area Executive Committee elections and any other elections conducted on the basis of the said compromised electoral register.
- (d) **A DIRECTIVE** establishing a Task Force at the national level, under the direct supervision of the National Secretariat and the Legal Directorate, to compile a fresh, credible, and verifiable electoral register for the Ablekuma West Constituency and to conduct or supervise all subsequent internal elections in the Constituency in accordance with the Party's Rules and Regulations.

- (c) **SUCH FURTHER OR OTHER DIRECTIVES OR DECISIONS** as the National Executive Committee shall deem fit and appropriate in the circumstances to safeguard the integrity of the Party's internal democratic processes in the Ablekuma West Constituency.

I. CONCLUSION

25. We trust that the National Executive Committee, true to the Party's enduring commitment to discipline, orderliness, transparency, and fairness, will treat this Petition with the urgency and seriousness it deserves, and will act decisively to remedy the wrong done to the membership of the Party in the Ablekuma West Constituency.
26. We thank you for your attention to this Petition and assure you of our continued loyalty and dedication to the cause and the values of the New Patriotic Party.
