RESPONSE TO ORDER OF THE COURT OF APPEAL
dated 28/05/26

Please be informed that

- i. The prosecution did not come into possession of pages 2 to 89 of the Advantage Solutions Company Limited's Account with Universal Merchant Bank (UMB Bank) which was filed with this Honourable Court on the 2nd Day of June 2025, and that the defence is already in possession of same having tendered the entirety of the bank statement of Advantage Solutions Company Limited at UMB Bank through the 2nd Prosecution Witness, which statement was admitted into evidence and labelled as Exhibit 15 and Exhibit 15A.
- ii. The prosecution has not come into possession of, and is unable to disclose the source of the Forty-Nine Million One Hundred Ghana Cedis (GHC49,100,000.00) lodged in the National Security Coordinator's special operations account which was subsequently transferred to the B.N.C Communications Bureau Limited's account with UMB bank.
- iii. The prosecution has not come into possession of, and is unable to disclose the file put together by Joshua Kyeremeh, at all materials times, Ghana's National Security Coordinator, relating to the acquisition of the cyber defence system.

- iv. The prosecution has not come into possession of, and is unable to disclose correspondence under the hand of Joshua Kyeremeh during his tenure as National Security Coordinator, and that of any other previous National Security Coordinator, relating to the vetting A2, and the use of A2 as a source of confidential assistance to National Security, or for the opening of the special purpose accounts intended for undercover National Security operations, using UMB Bank as the face.
- v. The prosecution has not come into possession of, and is unable to disclose the National Security Coordinators' special operations accounts.
- vi. The prosecution has not come into possession of, and is unable to disclose information from the immediate exited National Security Coordinator, as to whether the sum of Forty-Nine Million One Hundred Ghana Cedis (GHC49,100,000.00) converted by the Prosecution as Seven Million United States Dollars (US\$7,000,000.00) was meant for the importation of the cyber defence system alone.

The prosecution is therefore unable to produce the requested documents.
