GHANA WATER LTD COMPLETES Kpong-TEMA TRANSMISSION PIPELINE REPLACEMENT WORKS ON SCHEDULE

Water Production Resumes at Kpong Treatment Plant

Ghana Water Ltd (GWL) has successfully completed the replacement of the weak sections of the **21-inch and 42-inch (525mm and 1050mm) diameter Kpong-Tema transmission pipelines**, following the maintenance exercise that commenced on **Thursday, 6 August 2026**.

The works were completed on schedule, despite technical and operational challenges encountered during the exercise. Following the successful completion, water production has resumed at the Kpong Treatment Plant.

The restoration of supply will be progressive as the transmission lines and reservoirs are filled and operating pressures are gradually rebuilt. Barring unforeseen technical challenges, more consumers are expected to receive water as the system stabilizes.

Water Rationing Programme Remains in Effect

GWL wishes to emphasize that the resumption of production at Kpong does not mean a return to continuous water supply across all affected communities.

The Company's Water Demand Management and rationing programme remains in effect to ensure the equitable distribution of available water. Customers are therefore encouraged to continue observing their usual rationing schedules.

The Company appeals for continued patience as the network is gradually recharged, reservoirs replenished and pressures restored.

Managing Director Commends Maintenance Team

The Managing Director of Ghana Water Ltd, **Hon. Adam Mutawakilu**, who personally inspected the works at various stages, commended the engineers, contractors, maintenance

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team and technical personnel for their dedication, professionalism and resilience in completing the assignment on schedule.

He particularly acknowledged the leadership and commitment of the Lead and Chief Manager, ATMA Production, Ing. Dr. Hadisu Kappus Alhassan, and the General Manager in charge of Operations, Ing. Michael Botse Baidoo, together with their respective teams.
