POLICE ARREST TWO (2) SUSPECTS INVOLVED IN THE GOMOA DOMINASE ROBBERY

1. The Central East Regional Police Command has made a significant progress into the investigations of the robbery attack which occurred on Saturday 6th June 2026 at a mobile money vending point located at Gomoa Dominase in the Central Region which sadly resulted in the death of a 30 -year -old mobile money vendor.
2. Following the incident, relentless Police investigations continued until it was established that an iPhone 13Pro which was robbed off the deceased during the robbery attack had been activated. Upon the discovery through Police intelligence, suspect Isaac Baffoe, alias Kwame Cheddo believed to be part of the gang that carried the robbery was arrested at Kwesimintsim, Takoradi in the Western Region on 26th June 2026.
3. A search conducted on suspect Isaac Baffoe alias Kwame Cheddo led to the retrieval of the mentioned iPhone 13pro belonging to the deceased mobile money vendor which he the suspect had concealed in an iPhone 17 safety phone case together with other mobile phone accessories.
4. During interrogations, suspect Isaac Baffoe led Police to the arrest of suspect Prince Tawiah Baidoo, a phone technician at Kwesimintsim who confessed that he replaced the motherboard, Face ID component and camera sensors of the iPhone 13 pro at a repair cost of GHC. 2,650.00.
5. Following this confession by suspect Prince Tawiah Baidoo, a search was subsequently conducted at his place of abode which led to the recovery of a box containing the original components (motherboard, Face ID components and camera sensors) removed from the deceased 's iPhone.
6. Both suspects have since been put before the Ofaakor Circuit Court pending further investigations while the iPhone and its original and refurbished components have been retained as exhibits. Meanwhile, the Command has intensified its efforts to identify and arrest all members of the robbery gang as well as persons connected to the handling of the exhibit iPhone 13pro.
7. The Central East Regional Police Command urges the public to assist with the ongoing investigation. The Command further appeals to any person(s) with credible information to contact the Police Emergency numbers **191** or **18555**, or report to the nearest police station.
