**PETITION FOR POLICE INVESTIGATION INTO THE RECENT EXTORTION, KILLING,
ARMED ATTACK, ROBBERY, DESTRUCTION OF PROPERTY AND UNLAWFUL
OCCUPATION AT THE PREMISES OF NARAWA COMPANY LIMITED**

The management of Narawa Company Limited respectfully submit this Petition to the Ghana Police Service, requesting a thorough, impartial and independent investigation into the grave criminal incidents that occurred on 12th August, 2026, at our Client's mining premises.

On Wednesday, 12th August, 2026, at approximately 1030 hours, a heavily armed convoy of about six vehicles, including Land Cruisers, forcibly entered the premises of Narawa Mines. The group was led by individuals identified as Ebenezer Attah Fynn a.k.a Benjamin Doku a.k.a Ben, Flight Sergeant Robert Mensah, Sergeant Addo Simon, Sergeant Kwame Tonto, Corporal Awal Mohammed, LAC Kunya, Corporal Adu and several land guards. Ben and his accomplices claimed to be from **A & A Southern Industries Ltd. and CMS-PRO Indust. and Const. Ltd.** and included Eric Acheampong also known as Malaika and King Kwasi Amoah, who reportedly shot and wounded a police officer and a member of our client's security personnel respectively.

It is further alleged that the entire operation was carried out upon the instructions of one Abanga Yakubu Alhassan, the 3rd Vice Chairman of the National Democratic Congress (NDC).

During the raid, the assailants seized excavators and other valuable equipment belonging to the Company. They also made off with gold and gold concentrate worth over GHS100 million.

Following media coverage of the incident, the situation escalated further when Ebenezer Attah Fynn a.k.a Benjamin Doku a.k.a Ben and his accomplices set fire to several pieces of mining equipment on the premises. Among the assets destroyed were an industrial mobile washing plant, an industrial power plant, water and slurry pump machines and other items valued at over US\$2million. This destruction has caused substantial financial loss to our Client and threatens to severely disrupt its mining operations, employee welfare and contractual obligations.

In view of the foregoing, we respectfully petition the Ghana Police Service, through the Director of the Criminal Investigations Department, to:

1. Conduct a comprehensive investigation into the circumstances under which the armed group gained entry into the Narawa Mines premises, shot three persons including a police officer, and caused the death of one worker.
2. Establish the identities and specific roles of all individuals involved in the raid, robbery, and subsequent destruction of property, including but not limited to Flight Sergeant Robert Mensah, Ebenezer Attah Fyn (also known as "Ben"), and Abanga Yakubu Alhassan.
3. Investigate the allegation that Flight Sergeant Robert Mensah, Ebenezer Attah Fyn (also known as Benjamin Doku or "Ben"), Eric Acheampong (also known as "Malaika"), and King Kwasi Amoah carried out the raid and related acts upon the instruction of Abanga Yakubu Alhassan, the 3rd Vice Chairman of the NDC.
4. Determine who authorised or directed the seizure of the excavators, gold and gold concentrate worth over ghc100m which were stolen by the raiders, and other company property.
5. Ascertain the current whereabouts of the gold and other items removed from the premises.
6. Investigate the burning and destruction of the Company's mining equipment and identify all persons responsible for these acts of arson and vandalism.
7. Establish whether any public officials, military personnel, security personnel, or private individuals facilitated, participated in, or assisted in any of the incidents described above.
8. Obtain and examine all available evidence, including but not limited to CCTV footage, photographs, video recordings, vehicle registration details, telecommunications records, and any other relevant materials, in accordance with applicable laws.
9. Interview all witnesses, employees, security personnel, and other persons who were present before, during, and after the incidents.
10. Determine the full financial value of the property and equipment destroyed or removed.
11. Arrest, charge, and prosecute all persons found to be responsible for these criminal acts, in accordance with the laws of the Republic of Ghana.
12. Investigate and establish whether Ben and the persons alleged to be acting with him, including persons claiming to represent **A & A Southern Industries Ltd.** and **CMS-PRO Indust. and Const. Ltd.**, and whether the directors, officers, shareholders and ultimate beneficiaries of those companies, are in any way connected with, involved in,

or responsible for the reported incidents at Narawa Company Limited's mining operations, particularly in circumstances where they are alleged to have claimed that Narawa Company Limited's mining concession had been reassigned to them by the Minerals Commission.

The circumstances surrounding these incidents raise grave concerns about the security of private property, the sanctity of the rule of law, and the protection of legitimate business operations in Ghana. Narawa Company limited is a law-abiding corporate entity that has conducted its mining operations in full compliance with all applicable laws and regulations. The violent and unlawful actions described above constitute serious criminal offences under the laws of Ghana and must not be allowed to go unpunished.

We therefore respectfully urge the Ghana Police Service to treat this matter with the utmost urgency and seriousness, and to conduct a comprehensive, impartial, and evidence-based inquiry into all aspects of this case.

We further request that the management of Narawa Company limited be kept duly informed of the progress of the investigation and that all persons found culpable be dealt with in accordance with the law.

We look forward to your prompt attention to this matter.

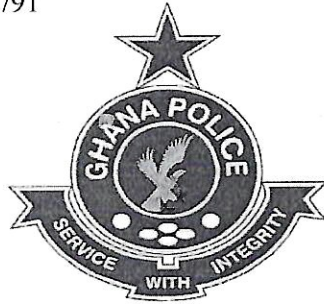

VEHICLES ALLEGEDLY USED IN THE NARAWA RAID





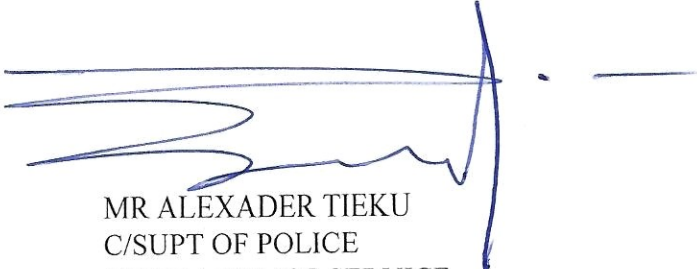

1. **DATE OF OFFENCE:** 16/08/2026 and 18/08/2026
2. **PLACE OF OFFENCE:** Akyem Osino
3. **NATURE OF OFFENCE:** Stealing and causing damage
4. **NAME & ADDRESS OF COMPLAINANT:** Kwame Amponsah of Narawa Mining Company
5. **NAME OF SUSPECTS:** Nil
6. **POLICE OFFICER INCHARGE CASE:** D/PW/C INSPR Monica Adidi
7. **BRIEF FACTS:** On 16/08 /2026 at about 7 50pm, Kwame Amponsah age 40 years accompanied by Samuel Yeboah on contact numbers 0534383535, 0244792916, all of Narawa mining company came to the station and reported that on 16/08/2026 at about 3.50pm, some civilians led by suspect Eric Acheampong alias "Maliaka", and some military officers in uniform came to their mining site and stole their quantity of refined gold, gold black concentrate two excavator machines and two pumping machines. On 24/08/2026, about 1. 00pm, Kwame Asamoah came to the station and again reported that on 18/08/2026 at about 5: 00pm, the same military officers came to the same mining site and used their Petrol and diesel to set the mining site ablaze causing damage to two Turning Tromill valued Gh ¢6.000.000.00, Power Plant valued Gh¢800.000.00, water engine machine valued Gh¢310,000.00, small generator valued Gh¢45.000.00, two Power bank valued Gh¢22.000.00, two Petrol valued Gh¢800.00, thirty (30) galloons of diesel valued Gh¢12,000.00, three grease guns valued Gh¢10,000.00 and stole one fridge valued Gh 4,000.00, weilding machine valued Gh¢45.000.00 and two pumping machines valued Gh¢22,000.00.
8. Police accompanied the complainant to the crime scene on 16/08 /2026 and 24/08 /2026, and the complainant showed police where the two excavator machines, two pumping machines, quantity of refined gold, gold black concentrate were kept before it was allegedly stolen, The complainant pointed to police a rubber bucket used by the suspects to allegedly steal the quantity of refined gold and gold black concentrate, Police observed that the two turning Tromills which were placed together were partly burnt with the other mining equipment listed by the complainant completely burnt. Photographs of the crime scene were as well taken.
9. Results of Police Actions. Efforts are being made to get the suspects arrested.
