PRESS STATEMENT

SUCCESSFUL COMPLETION OF VETTING OF ASPIRANTS FOR THE 2026 NATIONAL OFFICERS ELECTIONS

5th September 2026

The National Officers Elections Committee (NOEC) of the New Patriotic Party wishes to inform members of the Party, aspirants, the media and the general public that the vetting process for aspirants seeking election as National Officers of the Party has been successfully concluded.

The National Officers Election Vetting Committee (NOEVC) conducted the vetting exercise from **31st August to 3rd September 2026**, in accordance with the timetable published by NOEC.

In all, **forty-seven (47) aspirants**, contesting across **nine (9) categories of National Officer positions**, appeared before the Vetting Committee.

Following its examination of the documentation submitted by the aspirants, its interaction with them and its consideration of the applicable eligibility requirements, the Vetting Committee has submitted its report to NOEC.

OUTCOME OF VETTING

NOEC is pleased to announce that the Vetting Committee has recommended that **all forty-seven (47) aspirants who appeared before it are suitable and eligible to contest for the respective positions for which they filed their nominations**.

Accordingly, all 47 aspirants have been **CLEARED TO CONTEST**, subject to the processes provided under the applicable rules governing the elections.

The distribution of the cleared aspirants across the nine positions is as follows:

With the successful completion of the vetting process, NOEC will proceed with the next stage of preparations for the elections.

Balloting for positions on the ballot paper will take place on Wednesday, 9th September 2026, at the NPP Headquarters, Asylum Down, Accra.

Specific times for the balloting for the respective positions will be **communicated directly to the aspirants.**

Aspirants will be expected to participate in the balloting process either **in person or through their duly authorised representatives.**

NOEC urges all aspirants and their representatives to cooperate fully with the Committee to ensure an orderly and transparent balloting process.

NOEC expresses its profound appreciation to the Chairperson and members of the National Officers Election Vetting Committee for the diligence, professionalism and commitment with which they discharged this important responsibility.

The Committee equally commends all 47 aspirants for their cooperation and conduct throughout the vetting exercise.
