EXPRESSION OF CONCERNS ABOUT LIST OF TESCON VOTERS IN THE UPCOMING NATIONAL EXECUTIVES ELECTIONS

We write to raise grave concern regarding circulating reports about alteration of the list of Tertiary Students Confederacy (TESCON) members eligible to vote in the 3rd October National Executives elections of the New Patriotic Party.

TESCON is a vital organ of our party and allowing unauthorized adjustments, arbitrary deletions, or illegal stuffing of names on the voter register will threaten the very soul, credibility, and democratic traditions of the NPP. An election album that lacks integrity destroys trust before voting even begins.

The Boakye Agyarko Campaign Team wishes to state unequivocally that we shall reject any attempt, scheme, or maneuver by any entity to manipulate the electoral album to favor specific interests. Fairness, transparency, and strict adherence to the party's constitution must remain the guiding pillars of this internal contest. We therefore caution the National Elections Committee as follows:

1. Immediately halt any ongoing revisions or unilateral updates to the TESCON membership list outside of universally agreed-upon party guidelines.
2. Publish the authentic, verified album for all candidates and stakeholders' scrutiny to guarantee that only legitimate and duly qualified student members take part.

We hereby serve notice that The Boakye Agyarko Campaign Team will vehemently resist and protest any calculated attempts to engineer unfairness, skew the process, or cheat our collective democratic mandate.

We trust that your esteemed committee will act swiftly and decisively to correct these anomalies, uphold internal democracy, and safeguard the peace and unity of our party. We look forward to discussing further towards an urgent rectification of this matter.
